Camping Safety tips

Safety is easy to forget when you're enjoying the rally but by following just a few simple rules you will have a safe and relaxing time.

IN AN EMERGENCY CALL 999 and Inform the rally office

Carbon monoxide:

- carbon monoxide is a poisonous, colourless, tasteless and odourless gas. It can be produced when carbon (gas, wood, oil or coals) burns with insufficient oxygen.
- Symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning may include headaches, dizziness, nausea and breathlessness.

Gas leak:

- In a rare event of a gas leak report it to the rally office
- Don't smoke, use naked flame, operate electrical switches of mobile phone if there is a gas leak
- Please open doors and windows as you leave and turn the gas off

BBQs:

- NEVER take a portable barbecue, lit charcoal or a camping stove into an enclosed space like a tent, caravan, awning or camping pod, either for warmth or to cook
- Ensure all BBQs, stoves and camping lights are fully out before going to bed
- If using a disposable BBQ, MAKE SURE ITS OFF THE GROUND on an inflammable surface
- Open fires are not permitted during your stay

Fire

- There are fire extinguishers throughout the area. Please locate your nearest fire point
- Take great care with cigarettes.
- No naked flames
